OFFENSIVE DATA POINTS:

- ▶ Offensive formation (number of players slotted as running backs, wide receivers, tight ends and linemen)
- ▶ Huddle or no huddle
- ▶ Initial direction of the play (far left, left, middle, right, far right)
- ▶ Whether or not the offense was in motion before the snap
- ▶ Whether there was play action
- ▶ Who the quarterback was on every play
- ▶ Quarterback at pass (planted or on the run)
- ▶ Quarterback pocket location when he threw the ball
- ▶ Whether or not the quarterback was under center or in the shotgun
- ▶ Poorly thrown completions
- ▶ Direction of a designed quarterback rollout
- ▶ Handoff type (i.e. pitch, reverse, draw, etc.)
- ▶ Yards after catch
- ▶ Yard line of first contact
- ▶ Wide receivers bunched and the location of the bunch
- ▶ Tight end(s) location (on left or right)
- ▶ Receiver stays in-bounds with an unusual effort to do so
- ▶ Offensive player(s) that allowed sacks, hurries and knockdowns
- ▶ Protection time on sacks
- ▶ Reason for fumble (i.e. missed exchanged, jarred loose, etc.)
- ▶ Number of broken tackles on the play, if any
- ▶ Reason for incompleteness (i.e. dropped, thrown wide, knocked down, etc.)
- ▶ Pass yard line – where the ball was first touched or hit the ground
- ▶ Catchable passes

DEFENSIVE DATA POINTS:

- ▶ Number of defensive players on the line of scrimmage
- ▶ Whether the defense blitzed
- ▶ Whether the quarterback was hurried or knocked down
- ▶ Defenders whose tackles were broken or missed
- ▶ Defenders who knocked down the quarterback
- ▶ Defenders who were responsible for pass coverage
- ▶ Broken and missed tackles caused by the quarterback

SPECIAL TEAMS DATA POINTS:

- ▶ Bad snaps on field goal attempts and punts
- ▶ Hang time on punts and kick offs
- ▶ Number of yards the balls moved from scrimmage after a blocked kick
- ▶ Squib kicks

MISCELLANEOUS:

- ▶ Player who drew a penalty, the type of penalty and the number of yards penalized
- ▶ Whether a play was reviewed
- ▶ Whether a play was reversed
